Shakespeare's Globe Theatre and Little Ship Club

Join us for an afternoon guided tour of the spectacular Globe Theatre followed by a visit to the Little Ship Club for one of their regular 'Talk and Supper' evenings on Tuesday 25th February.

The speaker will be Charles Richardson who will talk about two extraordinary sailors – Captain John Illingworth, co-designer of Gipsy Moth IV, and his client, Sir Francis Chichester, who in 1967 became the first person to sail single-handedly around the world by the clipper route and the fastest person to circumnavigate the globe.

Before the talk there will be time for drinks in the bar and the opportunity to explore the club's facilities. After the talk, a two course supper will be served in the club's delightful dining room overlooking the Thames and the evening will finish in good time for the journey home.

The Little Ship Club is located next to Southwark Bridge, almost directly opposite the Globe Theatre on the south bank of the Thames.
