Norfolk Broads Autumn Cruise

Tuesday 12th – Tuesday 19th September 2023

Seven nights from only £299* per person

We do hope you will join us for another fun cruise on the serene and beautiful northern Norfolk Broads! The picturesque rivers and lakes that comprise the Norfolk Broads are best explored outside the peak season when they are much quieter and their beauty can be enjoyed to the full. We've again negotiated excellent group prices which will enable you to enjoy **seven days** of great boating for as little as £299* per person including evening meals on three of the seven nights. (* price based on six sharing)

The price of the seven day cruise includes:

- Boat hire
- A full tank of fuel
- > Parking
- Collision damage insurance
- Holiday cancellation insurance
- > Evening meals on three of the seven nights

Our outline itinerary will include:

- > Day 1 Board your boat and cruise to the location of our first night barbeque.
- > Days 2/3 Explore and spend the night on your own, or join the group at a designated location.
- > Day 4 Continue to explore, then join the group at a designated venue for an evening meal together.
- > Days 5/6 Explore and spend the night on your own, or join the group at a designated location.
- > Day 7 Continue to explore, then join the group for an end-of-cruise celebratory dinner.
- > Day 8 Cruise to Potter Heigham and return your boat.

On the free evenings you will have the option of choosing where you spend the night or joining the group at a designated destination. So that these designated overnight stops are accessible to all boats, they will all be in the central part of the Broads between Wroxham and Potter Heigham. Some larger boats cannot pass under Wroxham Bridge – and the ability of any boat to pass under Potter Heigham Bridge is dependent on the river level. When selecting your boat, note any bridge restrictions. If you would like to follow the meandering river Bure to the western perimeter of the Broads at Coltishall, you will need a boat that can pass under Wroxham Bridge. There are also several interesting areas to explore beyond Potter Heigham if your boat will pass under the bridge and the river level permits. There is however ample to see and do in the main central section of the Broads. We will hire our boats from Herbert Woods <u>www.herbertwoods.co.uk</u>, a large and professional company in Potter Heigham from whom we have hired before. Their extensive fleet comprises a mix of craft with differing features and sleeping capacities. We have provisionally reserved a number of boats to suit different requirements.

On the following pages you will find a list of boats and the costs per person depending on the number of people aboard. 'Standard' boats are broadly four star equivalent and 'Elite' boats are similar to five star. In all cases accommodation is in a private cabin – we are assuming members would not wish to use convertible sleeping accommodation in the saloon. The lists of boats also include links that will allow you easily to find out more about each boat.

Places are limited and boats will be allocated on a first come basis. **To reserve your boat, email** <u>jackie.m@tscc.org.uk</u> **as soon as possible.** To obtain best pricing we are required to pay the full hire cost at the time of booking. **We therefore need to receive your <u>payment in full minus £50.00 per head</u> no later than Friday 19th August.** Payment should be made in the normal way with the reference: "Broads"

Do remember that the price includes cancellation insurance so if, for example, you are unwell, your boat can be cancelled with a full refund less a £35.00 administration fee. Please see the attached terms and conditions and note that Covid cover is not included.

We will need your final payment of £50.00 per head no later than Tuesday 18th July 2023.
