

Join us for a guided tour of The State Apartments of the Speaker's House (plus an optional bite to eat nearby) Tuesday 24th September



The Speaker's House was completed in 1859 in grand Victorian style following the fire of 1834 that destroyed most of the Palace of Westminster. It is the home of the Speaker as well as a place where official business is transacted.

The tour focuses on the state rooms which are just as grand as those at Buckingham Palace. We will learn about the building as well as the history and the traditions of the role, and how the Speaker conducts official business.

We expect tickets for September to go on sale within the next month and we need to book them as soon as they become available. The cost of the tour will be £20.00.
